## Special Incentives for Completing Free Online Training

To be eligible for incentives:

- Must complete the online Incentive Intake Application at <https://feedmewords.org/early-educators>
- Must complete 5 to 10 hours of course work on [www.coxcampus.org](http://www.coxcampus.org) to include one of the "Power of Language" courses among the required 5-hour minimum (there are 2 versions to choose from)
- Must submit Cox Campus course transcript
- Must work at a licensed child care/early childhood learning facility, be enrolled as a student in the field of early childhood education, or be working in the field of early childhood education in Alabama
- Must submit a current (within the last 30 days) copy of pay stub with the name of the child care facility or agency displayed (waived if a student)
- Must submit a copy of your current student ID if enrolled in an Alabama early childhood education program
- Must submit a completed W-9 form

The Alabama Partnership for Children is required to collect a W-9 form from each individual completing the incentive program. The W-9 is needed so that, if necessary, a 1099 tax form can be sent to you for tax reporting purposes at the end of the year. Please note that the W-9 is for our financial records only, but we must receive the form for you to receive the incentive from our agency.

**Note: A maximum of \$200 can be earned per qualifying individual. Once all items are received, allow up to 60 days for processing the incentive payment.**
